LINO design – furniture maintenance

Compact laminates

To clean the surface on a daily basis, use a sponge or a soft cloth soaked in soapy water. It is possible to use a suitable organic thinner (acetone,...) to remove some types of stains, however, it is necessary to then rinse the surface with water and dry off with a paper towel. DO NOT USE any abrasive cleaning methods (cleaning powders, scourers, etc.) or bleaching agents, furniture polishes or waxes, strong alkaline cleaners, strong acid or salt containing agents.

Plates with phoenix finish (Oblique)

These plates have antistatic properties - therefore, dust does not settle. No special care is required: for cleaning purposes use a cloth and warm water with non-aggressive detergents.

Upholstered couches (Match) and armchairs

Remove stains from food and spilled liquid immediately using a clean wet cloth. Do not expose the furniture to direct sunlight, heaters or radiators as the heat may cause stains or bleaching of the upholstery. Most drink and food stains can be removed by using a wet cloth and a soap. Never rub the stain with a dry cloth. Larger and more resistant stains should be consulted with a professional cleaning company.

Fabric Aquaclean (Stelvio)

This fabric is very durable and easily washable by water. Do not add detergents to the cleaning water, the fabric is treated with a special product that forms a so-called "filter" and prevents dirt from penetrating the filler / foam. Use

The upholstered product should not be overloaded, eg by the weight of more people than the product is intended for, by jumping on the furniture, etc. The armrests and supporting parts of the furniture are not intended for sitting. The upholstered furniture is not intended for pets. If you cannot avoid the contact with animals, protect the upholstered fabric, for instance, use protective covers.

Plastic furniture

It is typical for plastic furniture that the dirt settles in the pores of the material. Clean plastic products using a soft cloth and warm water. For persistent dirt (stains) it is advisable to use soapy water. Do not use cleaning detergents containing ethyl alcohol, abrasives or any types of cleaning creams. Do not use rough fabrics.

Use

Do not place sharp objects that could scratch the material. Hot objects, such as pans or pots should not be placed on plastic furniture.

Metal furniture (powder coated)

Powder coating is the most durable metal finish method. Furniture is then resistant to scratching, shock, weather conditions. However, it is recommended to use a soft cloth and soapy water, without chemical cleaning agents, for maintenance. Then wipe dry with a soft cloth. Abrasive cleaning agents and solvents such as acetone can seriously damage the powder coating.
